Why does my laptop keep shutting down without removing the battery?

At times, when a system is forced to shut down without following the appropriate process (e.g., pulling out the battery), the laptop's Power Management settings get altered. We could fix it as follows: Press Win + R to open the Run window and type the command `powercfg.cpl`. Press Enter to open the Power Options window.

What causes a battery to shut down?

Battery malfunctions can create sudden shutdowns. A battery may have internal defects or age-related wear that affects its ability to supply power. An example is when a lithium-ion battery, which loses capacity over time, doesn't hold enough charge, leading to abrupt power loss.
