**Is 5G available in Hungary?**

In terms of commercial 5G service, the first operator that launched this service was Vodafone Hungary, in partnership with Huawei, in October 2019. It has continued to expand its 5G network coverage with the development of 5G base stations in larger rural towns and around Lake Balaton.

**How much does a 5G base station cost?**

Setting up a 5G base station is expensive, with costs ranging from \$100,000 to \$200,000 per site. This price includes hardware, installation, site rental, and maintenance. Urban areas often have higher costs due to land prices and infrastructure challenges.
