What is the cost structure of electricity generation technologies?

Cost structure of generation technologies. Electricity generation technologies vary dramatically in their cost structure. Some plants, such as nuclear, wind and solar power, have virtually zero variable costs. This is in stark contrast to fossil fuel based power plants.

How much does it cost to build a power station in Germany?

Block 5 of Irsching Power Station in Southern Germany uses natural gas as fuel in a combined cycle, converting 1,750 megawatts of thermal energy to 847 net MW of usable electricity. It cost EUR450 million to build. This works out to some EUR531 per kW of capacity.

Are energy costs high or low?

Capital costs tend to be low for gas and oil power stations; moderate for onshore wind turbines and solar PV (photovoltaics); higher for coal plants and higher still for waste-to-energy, wave and tidal, solar thermal, offshore wind and nuclear. Fuel costs - high for fossil fuel and biomass sources, low for nuclear, and zero for many renewables.

Which factors drive the cost of retail electricity prices?
